CONDUCTOR OF SYMPHONY & CHAMBER MUSIC DIRECTOR

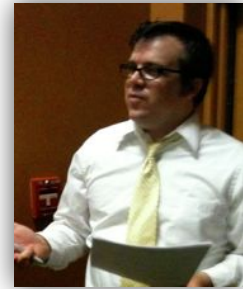
